MEET FORMAT	Session 1 - 1 st and 2 nd grade Session 2 - 3 rd and 4 th grade Session 3 - 5 th – 8 th grade
ENTRIES	Swimmers may enter in a maximum of one individual event and two relay events. Swimmers may be entered in individual and relay events in higher grades. Entries must be submitted electronically using Hy-Tek Team Manager Lite or Meet Manager. Handwritten, telephone or fax entries will not be accepted. Team Manager Lite is downloadable free of charge from Hy-Tek's website at http://www.hy-tek.com/downloads.html
ENTRY DEADLINE FEBRUARY 28, 2008	Electronic entries must be emailed to Rich Flaherty no later than FEBRUARY 28, 2008 . No additional entries or changes will be accepted after February 28, 2008. Rich Flaherty's email address is rich.flaherty@insightbb.com .
ENTRY TIMES	Swimmers should be entered at their best short course yards time for individual events. Swimmers entered with no time (NT) will be seeded randomly in the early heats of an event. The fastest seed times will swim in the final heat. All events are timed-final. Relays. Entry times are required for all A and B relays. All other relays should not have seed times and will be seeded randomly. Coaches are encouraged to list relay names on their electronic entries. Changes may be made up to the start of the race but must be noted on the relay cards and given to the lane timer.
ENTRY FEES	\$10 per swimmer entered in the meet. Entry fees are due when entries are due.
RULES	The meet will be conducted in accordance with the current NFHS Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where the rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated herein.

AWARDS	<p>Medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place (individual and relay)</p> <p>Ribbons for 5th -8th (Non-freestyle and relay events)</p> <p>Ribbons for 5th -16th (Freestyle individual events)</p> <p>Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place girls team</p> <p>Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place boys team</p> <p>Trophies for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place combined team</p>
CLERK OF COURSE	<p>All swimmers must report to the clerk of course for Sessions 1 & 2. There will be no clerk of course for session 3. Only designated representatives will be allowed in the clerk of course.</p>
RELAY CARDS	<p>Relay teams in sessions 1 & 2 will be given two relay cards. One card should be given to the lane timer and one card to the clerk of course. Any changes should be made to both cards. Relay teams in session 3 will be given one relay card per team which should be given to the lane timer. When the card is given to the lane timer, it should list all 4 swimmers on the relay (first and last names) in the correct order.</p>
T-SHIRTS	<p>CSAA Championship T-shirts will be available for each team to purchase. T-shirt orders must be given to Bert Erny by February 28, 2008. Bert can be contacted at 456-1993 or berny@b-systemslc.com.</p>
VOLUNTEERS	<p>Each school will be required to provide at least two volunteers per session (total of 6) to be a timer, clerk of course worker or safety marshal. Larger schools will be asked to provide additional volunteers. Please provide timers that have experience timing at a swim meet. Volunteers will be called to the head table one-half hour before the start of each session.</p>
